**"The Legend of Scarface and Bluewater"**

A Shawnee tribal tale of American Indian folklore and history, this story tells how the first Medicine Man came to be. We hope to secure funding to include a set design and props session of this workshop, as well as the chance to meet an American Indian drummer and work through the process of native rhythms, music and dance. This play will rehearse throughout the months of June and July, and rehearsal schedules will be available at the time of casting.

Please come prepared to your audition with the following:

- Your schedule of conflicts for the months of June & July, i.e. vacations, camps, etc.
- Dressed in comfortable clothing to move easily. Actors must be 10 by June, 2009.
- The awareness that a **sincere commitment** is necessary in order to be cast in this play.
- A self-created monologue based on a historical or imaginary American Indian figure. The monologue only needs to be 30 seconds or so, and during that time, the auditioner should walk onstage, introduce themselves as their character, and tell us a little bit about themselves. Please see one example below. Feel free to get creative and explore history!

"Hello, my name is Tecumseh. I belong to the Shawnee tribe and I have lived a very full life. I am the son of Pucksinwah, a **Shawnee** war chief who was killed at the **Battle of Point Pleasant**. I was born in Ohio, and I love my homeland so much that I have spent my whole life here, trying to unite other tribes to stand up and defend our tribal territory. I am a great warrior chief, and perhaps one of the most famous Indian leaders of history. Thank you for inviting me here to meet your people! I am both honored and grateful."
